

BCBA/BCaBA Coursework Requirements

Based on the BCBA/BCaBA Task List (5th ed.)

This document defines the coursework requirements for eligibility to become a Board Certified Behavior Analyst® (BCBA®) or a Board Certified Assistant Behavior Analyst® (BCaBA®). <u>Additional eligibility requirements</u>, such as acceptable degrees and supervised practical experience, must be obtained in order to qualify to take the BCBA or BCaBA exams. Coursework requirements under the <u>BCBA/BCaBA Task List</u> (4th ed.) are included for reference purposes.
